

BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT + EDUCATION

- 1 Business Financial literacy Accelerator Program
 - 14 small businesses participating and receiving \$1,000 each upon completion;
 - 8 professional instructors and presenters.
- Borderplex Commitment Equal Pay Campaign launched; 1 new website, 1 employer toolkit, 5 partners.



SUPPLIER DEVELOPMENT

- 11 companies matched through Buyer-Supplier Program, with 6 Buyers and 42 total supplier customer opportunities.
- 1 supplier familiarization tour; 7 company visits; 5 interested in expansion and 1 expansion.
- 5 supplier briefs developed with 400 opens.





WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT + TECH EDUCATION

- Creation of 2 new engineering graduate courses and 1 certification program in Product Design and Development
- Binational Technology Council conducted 1 Industry 4.0 training program for manufacturing suppliers and educators
 - 20 completion certificates to date;
 - Strategy team gave 9 presentations for 27 educators and 21 company representatives
